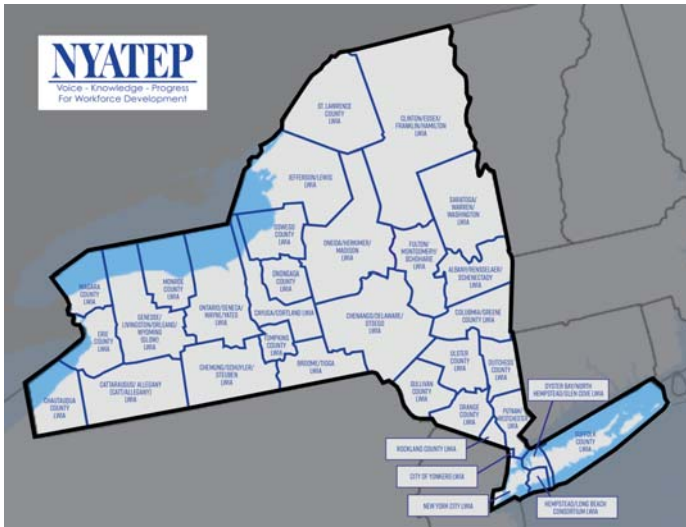

~\$300 million**

- Manage **\$115 million** in annual **WIOA** funding
- Leverage at least **\$35 million** in **other funding** for employment + training services
- Leverage **\$150 million** in non-WIOA funding for **Summer Youth Employment Program** (incl. ~\$40 million from State TANF funding)

**Serve ~400,000
people**

- Provide staff-assisted services to ~300,000 **adults** and **Dislocated Workers**
- Serve ~10,000 **youth** through **WIOA** programs
- Serve ~80,000 **youth** through **Summer Youth Employment Program**

**Serve ~27,000
employers**

- Engage nearly 500 businesses as **members of Local Boards**
- Serve at least 13,000 businesses
- Connect Summer Youth interns to employers at ~14,000 work sites
