Economic Self-Sufficiency Policy

Adopted 04/09/2021

Purpose

This policy defines the self-sufficiency level for the Capital Region Workforce Development Area.

Background

WIOA Section 134(b)(3)(A) requires that eligibility for training services for Adults and Dislocated Workers include a determination that the customer needs training services in order to obtain or retain employment that leads to economic self-sufficiency or wages comparable to or higher than wages from previous employment. The Capital Region Workforce Development Board has the responsibility for defining the self-sufficiency level for our local area.

Policy

The economic self-sufficiency level for Adults and Dislocated Workers is \$25.00 per hour.
